RETAINERSHIP AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Firm will implement an advocacy and communication program in support of the efforts of the I Am For Nana Foundation with the US government, the donor community, media institutions, non-governmental organizations, multi-lateral institutions, the philanthropic community and the private sector.

WHEREAS, the Firm has accepted the professional engagement offered by the Client and represents that it possesses the necessary expertise, skill, technical knowledge, ability and experience to render the required services to the I Am For Nana Foundation:

WHEREAS, the Firm will perform the following scope of work:

- Seek to mobilize support for a free, fair, and transparent electoral process in Ghana;
- Engage policy makers and stakeholders in Ghana, the US, and internationally to encourage their engagement and support for Ghana's political transition.
- Advise on a communications strategy, with a particular focus on international media, to convey the core tenets of Nana Akufo Addo's campaign, the candidate's vison for the country, the West African sub-region, and the continent.
- Provide in-country support as required and appropriate throughout the electoral process, keeping lines of communications with all election stakeholders open and productive,

NOW, THEREFORE, and in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements herein contained, the Parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:

- It is mutually agreed by the Parties to this Agreement that, the Firm performing the services herein above in this retainer agreement along with the statement of work incorporated by reference, shall be compensated with a fee of Seven Thousand Five Hundred United States Dollars (\$7,500.00) per month.
- It is mutually agreed that extraordinary expenses, including international travel, will be paid for by the client and are outside of the scope of the fees herein;

- This Agreement shall commence on June 1, 2016 and shall continue for a six month period, renewable on a month by month basis thereafter, upon agreement from both parties. This agreement may be terminated with or without cause by either party providing the other party thirty days written notice of termination.
